## TASTING NOTES HEXAMETER

## CH)

HEXAMETER is the meter that OVID used in his GREATEST POEM: Metamorphoses. This form of verse is uniquely SUITED TO the telling of long and inspiring tales that stand the test of time. We aim to recreate these qualities in the HEXAMETER wine, featuring our PRITCHARD HILL estate's most profound and COMPELLING Cabernet Franc as its core.

2022 began with a *dry winter*, the third in a row at OVID. COOLER TEMPERATURES and, though intermittent, *PERFECTLT TIMED* rains brought *budbreak* about toward the beginning of April, *classic timing* for our mountain top. *A MILD SPRING* graced us with a *BEAUTIFUL CROP* and made for canopies that were *well balanced*, providing DAPPLED LIGHT to our clusters. *Summer* was relatively uneventful, with *long* TEMPERATE DAYS. Early September brought a *PUSH OF HEAT* and kicked harvest off which lasted through the SECOND HALF OF SEPTEMBER.

The 2022 OVID HEXAMETER exudes *perfumes of sandalwood*, licorice root, bay laurel and *violet candies*. A SOLID CORE of *BLACK CHERRY*, currant, BLACKBERRY and *plum* provide a BROAD ENTRY and *depth* to the palate. *Freshness* and *VIBRANCT* radiate from this wine providing the framework to tell its tale with *verve and grace* for DECADES TO COME.

## OVID. NAPA VALLEY

OVID [PUBLIUS OVIDIUS NASO] WAS A ROMAN POET who lived from 43 BC until 17 AD. His most famous work, Metamorphoses, is A poetic retelling OF THE GREEK MYTHS, celebrating the themes of TRANSFORMATION and CHANGE.

PLANTED in 2000 on the rocky red, volcanic perch of PRITCHARD HILL, our organically certified, 15-acre vinevard is divided into ONE-ACRE blocks - each with a UNIQUE rootstock and clone combination of Bordeaux varieties. While TRANSFORMING our estate-grown grapes into OVID wines, we take care at every step and devote extraordinary technical attention to the vineyard to ensure the most AUTHENTIC EXPRESSION in the glass.

FOR OUR LABEL, we chose a quotation from OVID'S Metamorphoses that EXPRESSES what we hope to *achieve* with our wine:

PARTIMQUE FIGURAS RETTULIT ANTIQUAS, PARTIM NOVA MONSTRA CREAVIT. Partly we recovered the OLDE, FAMILIAR things, partly we created something WONDEROUS and NEW.
